傑出校友選拔暨表揚要點

Directives for Distinguished Alumni Selection and Commendation

Last Amended on May 29, 2019

- Article 1. National Taiwan Normal University (hereinafter referred to as “the University”) has formulated the *Directives for Distinguished Alumni Selection and Commendation* (hereinafter referred to as “the Directives”) to promote academic excellence as well as encourage and affirm outstanding achievements of alumni in terms of talent cultivation, service, academic research, and contributions to society.
- Article 2. Eligibility: Alumni who identify with University values with outstanding contributions to school establishment or development or are role models with outstanding achievements that benefit society may be nominated.
- Article 3. Number of Commendees: No more than 10 alumni per year in principle.
- Article 4. Location of Ceremony: Heping Campus I (No. 162, Sec. 1, Heping E. Rd., Taipei City)
- Article 5. Nomination Method:
1. The heads of all departments shall submit a list of candidates to the college’s Distinguished Alumni Nomination Committee (hereinafter referred to as “the Committee”) convened by the deans, who will propose a selection before November 30 for discussion and review.
 2. The number of nominees shall be one-third of total alumni and rounded up to the next whole number.
 3. Every first-level administrative unit may nominate one candidate and proceed as per Article 5, Paragraph 1.
 4. The Committee may submit a list of eligible alumni as per Article 2 based on the preceding 2 paragraphs for discussion and review.
- Article 6. Nomination and Selection Periods:
1. Nomination: From October 15 to November 30 in the year before the commendation.
 2. Selection: From December 1 in the year before the commendation to January 31 of the commendation year.
- Article 7. Selection Methods:
1. The Committee shall be composed of 9 to 12 members appointed by the President (convener) including representatives from the University, alumni, and other impartial units in society.
 2. During Committee meetings chaired by the convener, the Center of Public Affairs shall compile and report information on the candidates’ outstanding achievements, after which discussions and a vote shall be held. Candidates with votes from over two-thirds of attendees will be selected.
- Article 8. Awards and Commendations:
1. Presentation: At the ceremony, the President shall give a formal commendation and award each commendee with a medal and a

certificate to encourage future excellence.

2. Outstanding achievements shall be published in the University's NTNU Newsletter and press releases.
3. Distinguished alumni will be invited to share their career planning experiences, struggle for success, and mental journey at school or department (institute) assemblies to motivate students to excel.
4. A special issue covering outstanding alumni will be published and stored in NTNU University Archives and libraries.

Article 9. Organizer: Center of Public Affairs, Office of Administrative Affairs

Article 10. The *Directives* and any amendments thereto shall be implemented upon passage by the Administrative Council.
